ANTI-HISTAMINES	BONINE (Meclizine)	Breast feeding	Asthma, glaucoma, enlarged prostate gland, urinary problems, pregnant
	DRAMAMINE (Dimenhydrinate)	Breast feeding, taking Monoamine Oxidase (MOA) inhibitors or Sodium Oxybate (GBH	Asthma, glaucoma, enlarged prostate gland, kidney/liver disease, urinary system problems, irregular heart beat or heart disease, diabetes, ulcers, hypertension, pregnant
	MAREZINE (Cyclizine)	Breast feeding	Asthma, glaucoma, enlarged prostate gland, urinary problems, pregnant
	PHENERGAN (Promethazine)	Breast feeding; taking Monoamine Oxidase (MOA) inhibitors, anti-cholinergic drugs or propylthiouracil (PTU), taking anti-psychotics; suffering from Parkinson's syndrome or other extrapyramidal disorders	Epilepsy, sleep apnea, glaucoma, stomach ulcer, bone marrow disorder, hypertension, heart disease, liver disease, pregnant; taking sedatives, anti-depressants, narcotics, barbiturates, or any other drugs
	STUGERON (Cinnizarine)	Breast feeding; suffering from porphyrias (hereditary blood disorder)	Hypotension, kidney/liver disease, Parkinson's syndrome or other extrapyramidal disorders, pregnant
SCOPO LAMINES	TRANSDERM SCOP(OLAMINE) (Hyoscine)	Breast feeding	Asthma, glaucoma, enlarged prostate gland, kidney/liver disease, urinary system problems, irregular heart beat or heart disease, psychotic illness, stomach or intestinal blockage; taking anti-cholinergics; children; elderly; pregnant
	SCOPACE Hyoscine	Breast feeding	Asthma, glaucoma, enlarged prostate gland, kidney/liver disease, urinary system problems, irregular heart beat or heart disease, psychotic illness, stomach or intestinal blockage; taking anti-cholinergics; children; elderly; pregnant
