- **3.** The head was re-plumbed to comply with California laws. A lockable, two-way Y-valve was added, as were a rigid holding tank, deck pumpout, and an above-the-waterline vented loop.
- 4. The aft view BEFORE.
- **5.** The aft view AFTER. Among the projects still on the to-do list is installing the distribution panel.
- 6. Our favorite customization: the teak-topped throne.
- 7. Stripping, sanding, and repairing the salvaged trim was quite the task. A 90-vice was handy for joinery work.
- 8. A damaged section of the starboard toerail was replaced.
- **9.** The spots where a previous owner had just painted over peeling antifouling had to be sanded to the fiberglass and faired.
- **10.** A new cabin sole was constructed of 15 square feet of teak battens, Teakdecking Systems teak caulk, and phenolic backing, similar to a pre-fab teak deck.
- 11. Satori sits after three coats of new ablative antifouling.
