



## Hawkeye Floats to the Top with a Simple, Rugged Form Factor

Testing on the water and on the bench revealed several key differences between the Hawkeye 22PX and the Speedtech SM-5A:

1. The Speedtech included an optional Airmar P72 transducer with suction-cup bracket, which made it easier to record soundings while underway.
2. Small, vulnerable lead wires and terminal connectors are just one of the drawbacks of the Speedtech's 9-volt battery arrangement.
3. Both units were relatively easy to view day or night. The Hawkeye has slightly larger digits.
4. Easy to load, clean, and inspect, the AA battery compartment on the Hawkeye made for a sensible arrangement for marine use.
