



Installation Options

The simplest installation is a basic pole mount (above left), which puts blades safely out of reach. This twin installation will boost output, but interference between the two units means you can't expect to double output. Dual-purpose mounts (top right) are typical in this electronic age. For best production

underway or at anchor, a mizzen-mounted generator (bottom right) should be allowed to rotate. Using a riding sail at anchor will help keep the boat pointed into the wind. This installation is the quietest and will appeal to ketches with aft cabins. However, maintenance will be difficult, and reliable braking is key.
